

**DEBTS OWED TO COURTS; FAILURE TO COMPLY
WITH A TRAFFIC CITATION**

Consistent with the authority granted to the district courts in K.S.A. 20-169, and particularly K.S.A. 20-169(b)(4), the Clerks of the District Court of Butler, Greenwood, and Elk counties are authorized to refer all "debts owed to courts" as defined in that statute to this district's authorized contract collection services provider. Such "debts to courts" that may be referred to collections shall specifically include "court costs, fines, fees, or other charges arising from failure to comply with a traffic citation within 30 days from the date of the mailing of the notice pursuant to K.S.A. 8-2110(b)(1), and amendments thereto." Any previous policy statement contrary to the above is hereby rescinded.

Nothing in this administrative order shall be construed to change any other existing district policy or statutory limitation on the referral of specific debts to collection.
